

The way of the Jubilee

If you want to experience the Jubilee, here is the route to follow:

The present day hospital
(Formerly the old hospice) it is in the chapel of the old hospice that Bernadette made her first Holy Communion, on the 3rd of June 1858 before the last apparition of the 16th July 1858. Mary is the way to her Son. The source and summit of the Christian life is the Furbarist



If you enter the domain by St. Michael's gate you will walk along the Jubilee Avenue which will be specially created for the jubilee Year. In the domain you will find the information you need. The 200 metre walk will help you to focus your mind and heart to visit the Grotto. To the right of the Rosary Basilica you pass under the arches to make your way to the grotto. On each arch you will see an image of Christ. On arrival at the Grotto you will find a place of prayer, a p-lace to pray with confidence in a loving God.

The cachot on the Rue Petits-Fosses
It was in the cachot that the Soubirous family were living in 1858. this was a place of extreme poverty, we recall the words of the Magnificat: "he has pulled down the powerful and raised up the lowly" we can think of Jesus, the Son of man who had nowhere to lay his head, we can remember the Beatitudes, happy the meek, the kingdom of heaven is theirs.

The parish church in the old town
The parish church has the baptismal font in which Bernadette was baptised on the 9th
January 1844. For the Christian, a pilgrimage is an opportunity to rediscover their own baptism and to renew their baptismal promises.

ix million people come to Lourdes every year
Why do they come? They come because Lourdes is a different place:

- A place where Christians can freely express their faith
- A place where the sick and people with disability have priority
- A place of prayer, of service and fraternity between people
- A place that children and young people say is "super"
- A place where a person can be open to God

The story of Lourdes began in 1858 when the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Bernadette Soubirous. Since then the number of pilgrims has increased each year. It is a place of spirituality that helps people to live in our world today.

The story of Lourdes is written each day by the pilgrims who come here, it is a living story. After 150 years people still come to give thanks.

This year we will give thanks for graces received, we will discern God's will as we embark into the 3rd millennium and we will make more available the service of the sanctuary.

It is for these reasons that the Jubilee year will last for a full 12 months. It will begin on the 8th December 2007, the feast of the Immaculate Conception and will continue until 8th December 2008. Come in winter when you might have the place to yourself or almost.

Several hours later the water was still running clear and does so to this day. This is a beautiful sign of conversion, a sign leading to the penitent to the joy

The passage through the Grotto, the Stations of the Cross, the Water Walk and the baths are all signs and ways in which we can express and experience our desire for reconciliation, leading to a celebration of the sacrament of reconciliation. This is inextricably linked to our participation in the Eucharist and we are promised to receive many blessings during this Jubilee Year.

When the Pope gives the blessing "Urbi et Orbi" to the Church and the World in numerous languages we have a sense of the universality of the Church.

This is expanded at the nightly Torchlight procession when many languages are used in the praying of the Rosary and in the singing of the "Ave Maria"

The language of signs and gestures is however universal, this is clearly seen at the Grotto, the spring and the Way of the Cross.

The is a town that is overlooked by the ancient chateau fort. It is a reminder that peace was not always present in these mountains. The fort played a vital role in protecting the town and the surrounding area. Certain dates are worth remembering, 1870, 1914-1918, 1939-1945.

During these times of war and conflict Lourdes welcomed the sick and injured. After the wars, Lourdes prayed for the mort, consoled the living and worked for peace.

It is this spirit that we need to understand the International Military Pilgrimage that brings together men and women who in former times had been enemies. It was to Lourdes, after the Second World War, that German soldiers came on pilgrimage.

Who knows better than a soldier, the horror of war and the price of peace!!

After spending sometime in Bartres, Bernadette returned to Lourdes to prepare for her first Holy Communion. During her preparation the Lady of the Grotto reassured her. Bernadette made her first Holy Communion on the 3rd June 1858 in the Chapel of the Sisters of Nevers in Lourdes. This is the 4th stop on the Jubilee Way.

Mary asked that a chapel be built. After the Apparitions were recognised the bishop and priests wasted no time in responding to Our Lady's request.

Before she left Lourdes for the last time, Bernadette was able to attend Mass at the Grotto and in the upper Basilica.

Very soon after this the Blessed Sacrament procession and the blessing of the sick was inaugurated. This is one of the main events that take place every day in Lourdes.

Adoration is also very important in Lourdes and there are several places where this takes place. The "Tent of Adoration" is the most recent place.
